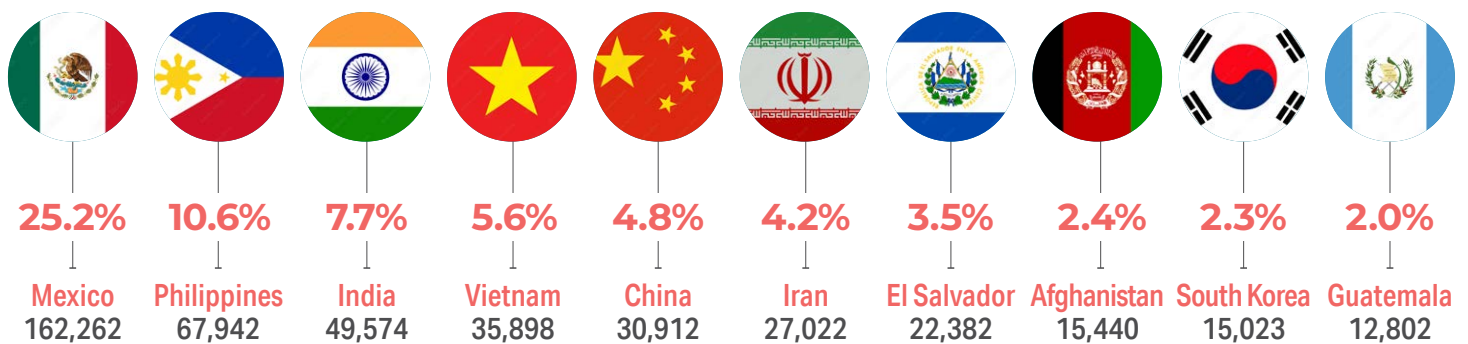

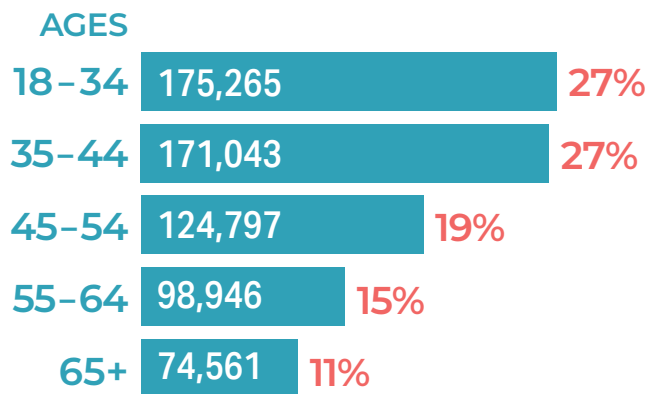
# +643,000

Since the last presidential election in November 2020, an estimated **643,612** people have become newly naturalized citizens in California.<sup>1</sup>
