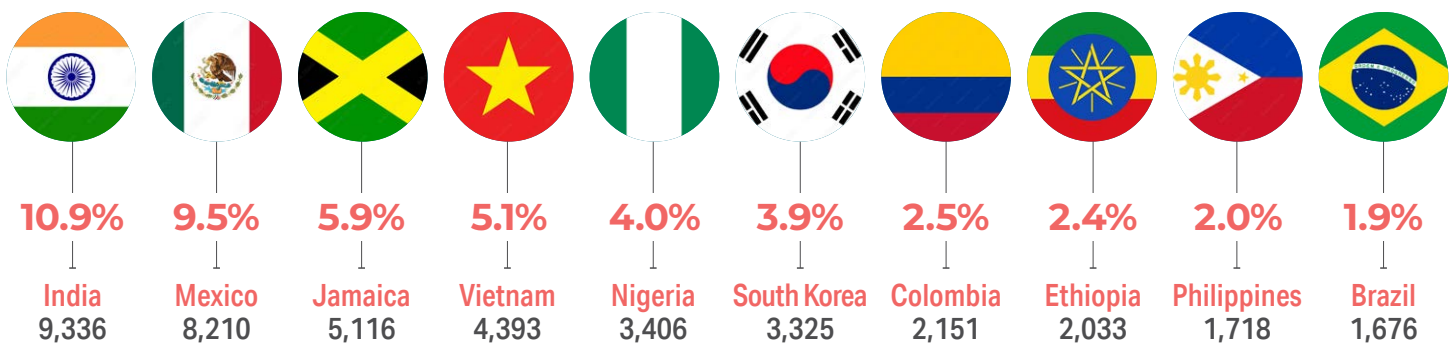

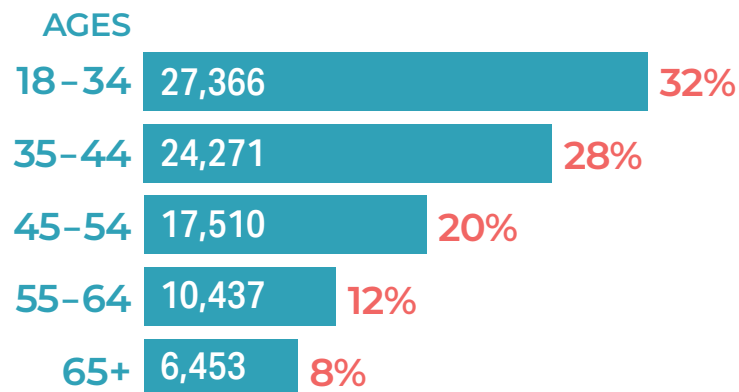

Since the last presidential election in November 2020, an estimated **86,037** people have become newly naturalized citizens in Georgia.<sup>1</sup>
