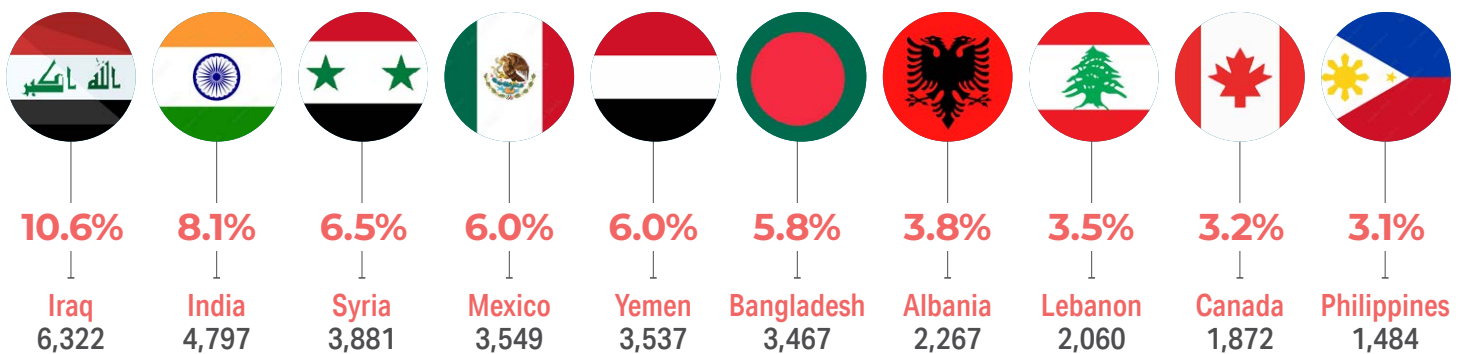

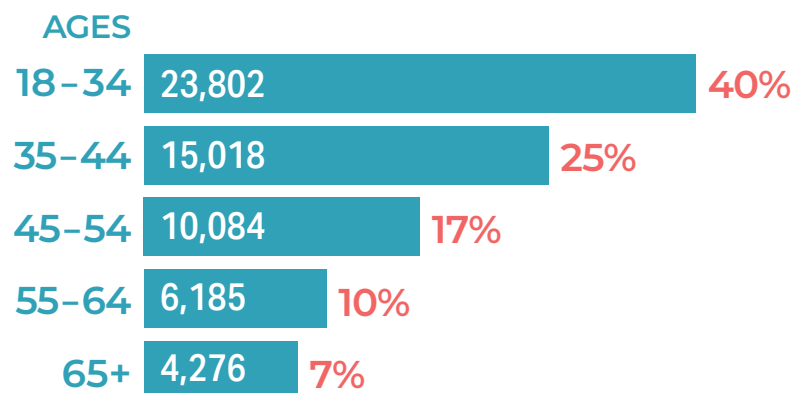

Since the last presidential election in November 2020, an estimated **59,365** people have become newly naturalized citizens in Michigan.¹

1. Naturalization statistics are estimates based on data from the Department of Homeland Security. For the statewide total, we impute missing data (for FY2023 and FY2024) based on a 25-year trend in naturalizations using ordinary least squares regression to make a linear prediction.
