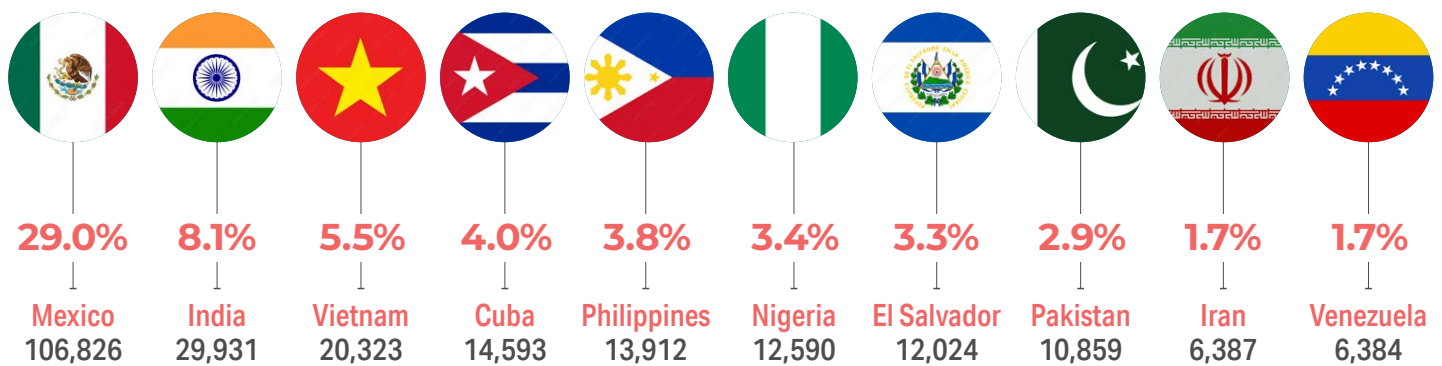

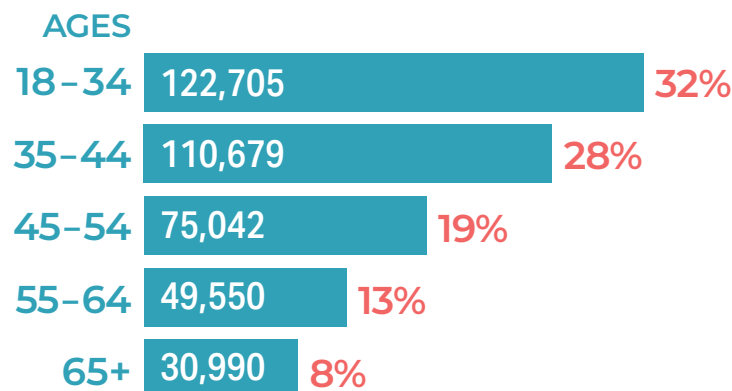

Since the last presidential election in November 2020, an estimated **368,996** people have become newly naturalized citizens in Texas.<sup>1</sup>

1. Naturalization statistics are estimates based on data from the Department of Homeland Security. For the statewide total, we impute missing data (for FY2024) based on a 25-year trend in naturalizations using ordinary least squares regression to make a linear prediction.

2. Country-of-origin, age, and gender distributions calculated using latest publicly-available state-level DHS data from FY2022.
